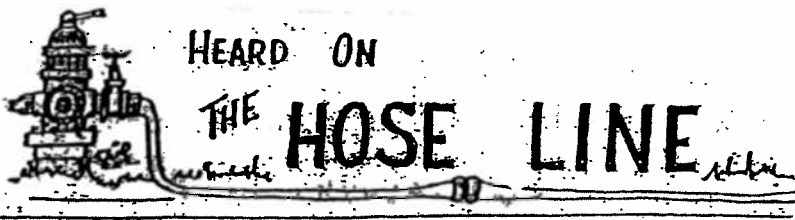
SEASON'S GREETINGS TO ALL:

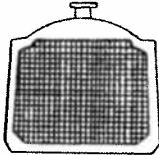

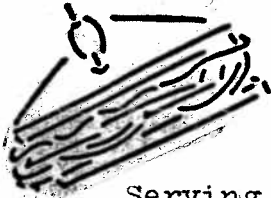
