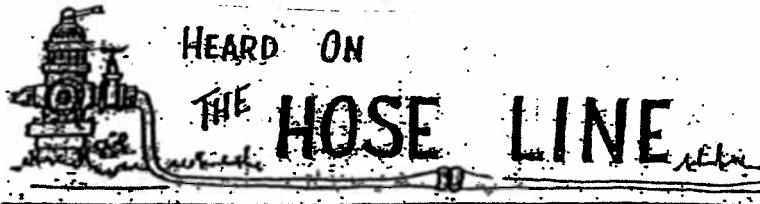

## HARRY HAYES: FORMER PORT CHESTER FIRE DEPARTMENT FIRE CHIEF PASSES AWAY

---

Harry Hayes, a longtime Port Chester resident and former Port Chester fire chief passed away on December 31st, 2010 at Greenwich Hospital at age of 84.

Born in Port Chester, he was raised in Port Chester and Purchase and graduated from Port Chester High School in 1944.

After graduation, he served in the U.S. Navy from 1944-46 holding the position of fire control seaman.

He returned to Port Chester after the war and attended Iona College on the G.I. Bill.

Harry was employed as a service representative and auditor for Homelite Corp for 33 yrs. before retiring 1984. He traveled the country setting up branches of the company with made generators, pumps and chainsaws.

In 1954, Harry joined Washington E&H Co. #4 of the Port Chester Volunteer Fire Department to which he served for 56 years. He was honored in 2004 for 50 years of service.

He served all three firematic officers from 1971-1976. He also served on many company committees and was president of the company in 1978.

In 1979, Harry was elected Second Assistant Chief of the Port Chester Fire Department. In 1981, he was elected 1st Assistant Chief and in 1983, he was elected Chief Engineer of the Port Chester Fire Department all two year terms.

During his tenure, Harry was confronted with some large fires such as Port Chester Plate Glass.

Over the years, he was involved in fighting at least six major fires, including Gulliver's Nightclub on June 30th, 1974, where he personally lifted six of the 24 people who died from smoke inhalation out of the club.

Harry remained active in the Port Chester Fire Department un-

til his death.

As past chief, he served as Secretary of the Sound Shores Chief Association from 1984 to 1994 and was on the original fire department golf committee. Most recently he served as a representative on the Port Chester/Rye Brook Fire Advisory Board.

He was a parishioner of Corpus Christi Church in Port Chester.

An avid golfer, he played in a tournament as recently as the end of September.

He also like traveling to Florida and owned a condo in Pembroke Pines.

Harry was known for his caring nature, giving elderly people rides to doctor's offices, helping people during personal dilemmas and quietly volunteering his times for different causes.

According to former Fire Chief William Nethercott, Harry was like a father to many of the younger firefighters in the Port Chester Fire Department.

He is survived by a sister, Dorothy Renfro of Spring, Tx., nine nieces and nephews and many grandnieces and grandnephews, all of Texas.

He is also survived by his longtime companion, Mary Acerbo of Port Chester.

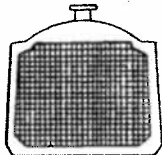
