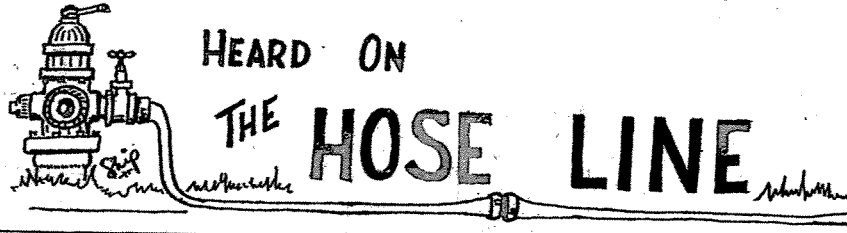
After the meal it was clean up time which everyone pitched in.

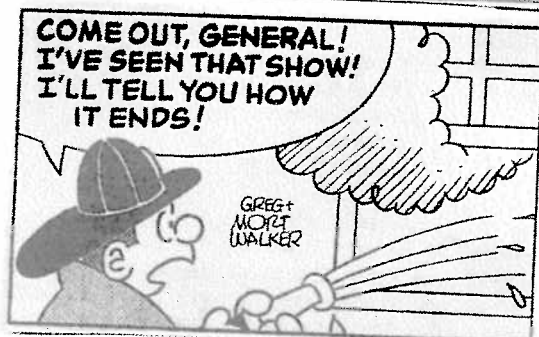

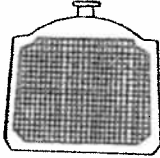

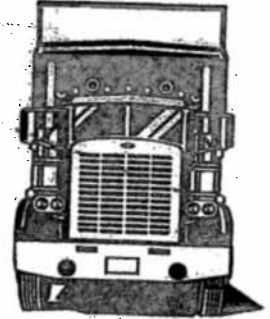
